



## Speech-Language Therapy Fraser® Rehabilitation Services

**Speech-language therapy** assists children with delays or difficulties in language and communication, speech production, social communication, eating, and swallowing.

Fraser speech pathologists use play and structured activities to evaluate and develop:

- prelinguistic skills
- language skills
- language processing
- articulation skills
- oral-motor skills
- feeding and swallowing abilities
- social communication skills
- augmentative alternative communication skills.

Speech-language therapy is provided through **Fraser Rehabilitation Services**, which provide comprehensive evaluation, consultation, and treatment services for children with motor and sensory dysfunction, decreased functional and developmental skills, feeding and swallowing difficulties, and speech, language, and hearing disorders. These therapy services are provided with an interdisciplinary approach and each child's goals and activities are individualized, based on strengths, challenges, and motivations. Fraser therapists collaborate with parents, caregivers, teachers, and mental health practitioners to maximize results.

### **Ages Served**

Most programs are designed for children up to 7 years of age. Children older than 7 may be served depending on the child, program and the treating therapy team.

- Fraser speech-language pathologists have master degrees and are licensed to practice in the state of Minnesota.
- Fraser speech-language pathologists hold the Certificate of Clinical Competence through the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association or are completing their clinical fellowship year (CFY).
